- You must be aged 18 years and over, eligible to vote and have lived or worked in the parish of Crick for 12 months or more, or within 3 miles of the parish boundary.
- Any elector can identify a potential councillor and nominate candidates for election and have the right to elect a councillor who represents their interests.
- Unless ten electors of the Parish give written notice to the Proper Officer of Daventry District Council by 3<sup>rd</sup> July 2018 (*Elections Section, Daventry District Council, Lodge Road, Daventry, NN11 4FP*), requesting an election to fill this vacancy, the Parish Council will fill the vacancy by co-optation at its March meeting.
