However, the trees should not be moved until the autumn and the name plaques need to remain with the trees also. ▪ Cllr. Fursman is to review the tree outside of Oak Cottage to see if this can be replaced using one of the Bury Dyke commemorative trees. ▪ Council agreed that the original plans need to be reviewed concerning the hawthorn bush before a decision can be made, as the hedge could of protected status, and the neighbour also needs consulting.
